Dear Thoughtful Discussion Participant: This set of suggestions and questions for Small Group Discussion is deliberately patterned after one offered two months ago after reading the Epistles of Galatians and Colossians in public worship. At Countryside we place great value on these times in the Scripture. This guide is meant to direct this week's discussions so that they pick up where they left off earlier in the summer.

1 Timothy 4:13 Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to preaching and to teaching.

Colossians 4:16 After this letter has been read to you, see that it is also read in the church of the Laodiceans and that you in turn read the letter from Laodicea.

1 Thessalonians 5:27 I charge you before the Lord to have this letter read to all the brothers.

Revelation 1:3 Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near.
