- **Hebrews 2:11** Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers.
- **Romans 8:29** For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.
