The book of Hebrews compares and contrasts Jesus to key historical people and events from the Old Testament. Through these comparisons, we see His superiority. He is greater than angels, the Torah, Moses, the Promised Land, priests, Melchizedek, sacrifices, and the covenant. He is God's Word, the hope for a new creation, our eternal priest, and the perfect sacrifice.

Throughout the book, we are also challenged to remain faithful to Jesus and follow great models of faith from the Old Testament despite hardships and persecution. Jesus is the ultimate revelation of God's love and mercy and is worthy of all our trust and devotion.

## Small Group/Home Fellowship discussions could be from anywhere in this magnificent letter. Some of the following verses might provide fodder for your consideration:

- ✓ Hebrews 1:3-4 (WHAT do we see from/in/because of Jesus?)
- ✓ Hebrews 4:12-13 (WHO is the Word of God?)
- Hebrews 4:15 (WHY is this of value?)
- ✓ Hebrews 10:24-25 (WHAT are the implications of this, and to WHOM is it addressed?)
- Hebrews 11:1 (WHAT about doubt?) and also the next verse...
- Hebrews 11:6 (DOES THIS MEAN doubt is sin? [Hint: Not necessarily...])
- Hebrews 12:1 (We're surrounded... WHAT?)
- ✔ Hebrews 12:2 (The WHO is the ultimate point. Re-look at Hebrews 1:3-4)
- Hebrews 12:14 (WHAT is our obligation? Connect this to Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Hebrews 13:1 (and 10-24-25 and 12:14 WHY keep coming back to this?)
- Hebrews 13:8 So, WHAT can change and WHAT could that mean?)
- ✓ Hebrews 13:17 (extra credit for this very important question!) ☺
