① → As you think about past readings of this parable, who was the sower?

- ✓ What's the best part of discovering that the Sower is first, Jesus?
- ✓ How do you feel about being a sower? Are you sowing well?

② → As you think about past readings of this parable, what was the seed?

- ✓ What's the best part of discovering that the seed is the gospel, and in the end, Jesus Himself?
- ✓ What is the Gospel?

③ → Jesus expresses that his teaching (proclaiming the Gospel) is like seeds. What does Jesus expect to happen in response to his teaching? What does Jesus not expect?

④ → What makes the difference in how the plants grow?

- ✓ Does this shape our understandings of spiritual maturity? How?

⑤ → Which soils are good and which soils are bad?

- ✓ Does this shape our understandings of what a disciple is (or a Christian is)? How?

⑥ → **Extra credit:** Jesus ends the story by saying, "Listen, then, if you have ears." What do you think he means by this?
