Luke 9:16-17 ¹⁶ Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks blessed them and broke them. 3→ To consecrate, set apart

Mark 6:41; how might James' words fit into Jesus' actions during the feeding of the 5,000?

4 → To act kindly towards

Hebrews 6:13-14; how might the writer of Hebrews' words fit into Jesus' actions during the feeding of the 5,000?

5→ What do these insights into Jesus' Eulogeo-izing mean for you? Your prayer life? Your interactions with the hand of God in others? Your table matters?
