①→ Discuss what v62 means, and what it doesn't mean. Do you bend Jesus' actual meaning for your day to day life in this world? How?

2 → Describe the barriers you perceive as significant for radically following Jesus?

(3)→ How would Luke 6:27-28 characterize what we see in Luke 6:51-62? How is Jesus being consistent?

④→ Does actual belief always shape behavior?

 $(5 \rightarrow \text{Does actual belief always shape outcome})$

 $6 \rightarrow$ Jesus responds in vss 55,58,60,62; what is Jesus stressing?

 $7 \rightarrow$ Discuss how Hebrews 12:1-3 applies to all of Jesus responses, especially v62.

(3)→ Extra credit discussion if you dare: The Kingdom is an upside down Kingdom compared to the world in which we live. This causes us problems because we try and live as Kingdom citizens in the context of this world. In reality we're living in this world in the context of the Kingdom. These are not the same. For us, the foundation is the Kingdom of God, not the world in which we live.
