① Jesus would continue to be with the disciples through his Spirit — He'd be present, he'd be there. Jesus continues to be with us today through his Spirit —Immanuel, "God is with us" (Matthew 1:23) Terry mentioned that we sometimes make a bit too much distinction between the Son and the Spirit? How can this hurt or hinder?

2 Jesus reveals Himself in and through the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the spirit (cf: 1 Corinthians 12:7-11), and in the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). How is the Holy Spirit being revealed in you? Through you? How is the Holy Spirit NOT being revealed in you and through you?

- 3 A couple weeks back we talked about how the resurrection provides Open doors. The present Holy Spirit magnifies those doors, and even provides urgency and power. What does that mean for:
- the Gospel?
- your neighbor?
- the Episcopalian, the Catholic, the Muslim?
