1 We prayed a bookend: • Matthew 6:9-10 9 "This, then, is how you should pray: "'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, 10 your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

We pray this, how do we act it, behave it, and believe it in?

- 2 Can you see the "bookends"? How does the body of the prayer (below) affect what is prayed in verse 10?
- 3 Matthew 6:11-13 11 Give us today our daily bread.

How expansive is your bread?

4 ¹² Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

Explain your debts... how are others indebted to you? How do you respond to their debtedness?

5 ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.'

How can we best not be led tempt6ation's way? What steps can we take and expect deliverance?

6 → <u>And the other bookend</u>: • Matthew 6:13B ["for yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen."]

Terry emphasized, and reemphasized, that the Kingdom is GOD'S KINGDOM. Why was this emphasis made? How does this shape our thinking? Does this reflect our thinking?
