• **PROVERBS 6:16-19**¹⁶ There are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to him: ¹⁷ haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, ¹⁸ a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, ¹⁹ a false witness who pours out lies and a man who stirs up dissension among brothers.

1 Which is your favorite detestable thing (expressed in its regular use)?

2 Is this (are these) a bad thing you do, or a detestable thing that you are? Explain.

• **2 CORINTHIANS 5:21** God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

3 <u>What does this say about this (these) bad thing(s) you do, or the detestable thing(s) you are that you talked about in **2**? <u>Explain.</u></u>

4 What does this say about your favorite detestable thing (expressed in its regular use)?

5 How serious should we take this? How do we take this seriously?

• **Proverbs 6:19** [God detests] a false witness who pours out lies and a person who stirs up conflict in the community. [other translations read: among brothers]

• **TITUS 3:10-11** Warn a divisive person once, and then warn him a second time. After that, have nothing to do with him. ¹¹ You may be sure that such a man is warped and sinful; he is self-condemned.
