- → Advent. That's a lot of waiting. Matthew 1:23 addresses the wait in a Word (reiterating Isaiah 7:14).

- 2→ What are all the ways the message of these verses addresses the waiting expressed in the Gospel accounts, by the people alive at that time?
- 3→ What are all the ways the message of these verses addresses the waiting of the church, the waiting we're doing now?
- $4\rightarrow$ In regard to the last question, what are we the church, now actually waiting for?
- **5**→ Do these verses add to hope, or have you already talked about these in the four questions above?
