① Mark 1:15-17 ¹⁵ "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!" ¹⁶ As Jesus walked beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. ¹⁷ "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men."

① What does it mean "the time has come" and the "Kingdom of God is near"?

② The statements in the previous statement ARE THE Gospel? How are they the Gospel?

③ How do we respond to the Gospel?

④ What does the Gospel look like in the Christian long-term?

② Expand on the last question (① ④) from this passage: Mark 8:34-35 ³⁴ Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. ³⁵ For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me and for the gospel will save it.
